
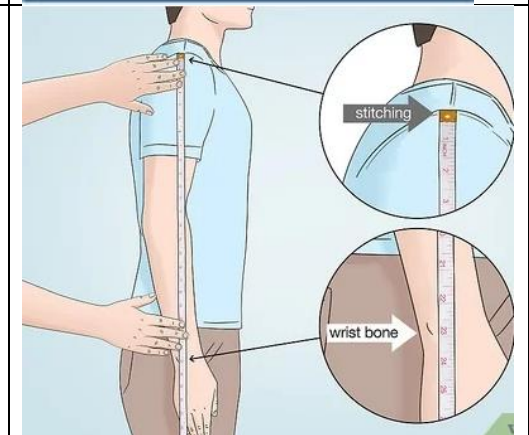
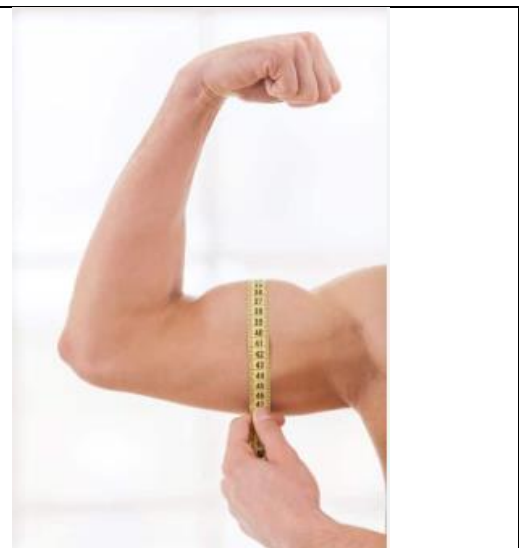








HOW TO MEASURE KAFTANS

| <p>Measuring length Shoulder</p> | <p>We are looking for the distance between the two farthest points on your shoulders; place the tip of your tape on one point (one shoulder) and you trace that across to the other side (the other shoulder). That distance is the measurement. Please write down the length displayed on your measuring tape. That distance is the measurement to provide to us.</p> <p>For reference, please see demonstrative image to the right.</p> |  |
| <p>Measuring length Sleeve</p> | <p>Place your measuring tape at the highest point of the arm. Hold the measuring tape at that point, and trace the tape down until you reach your wrist bone. That distance is the measurement. Please write down the length displayed on your measuring tape.</p> <p>Please write down the length displayed on your measuring tape.</p> <p>Please be sure to measure both arms. To ensure the best fit to your body.</p> <p>For reference, please see demonstrative image to the right.</p> |  |

| <p><i>Measuring width or circumference of bicep</i></p> | <p>Form a very tight bicep contraction. Once your bicep is firm, place the measuring tape around your bicep. Do not make it tight, but comfortable because this is how your shirt will fit around this part of your arm.</p> <p>Please note the measurements.</p> <p>Please look at the diagram for reference.</p> |  A photograph showing a person's right arm flexed at the elbow. | <p><i>Measuring width or circumference of wrist</i></p> | <p>Please do the same for your wrist.</p> <p>Please note the measurements.</p> |  An illustration of a hand and wrist. A blue measuring tape is wrapped around the wrist. A hand is shown holding the tape measure. |

| <p><i>Measuring width or circumference of chest</i></p> | <p>Take your measuring tape around the back and bring it forward to where you can see. Now, make it as firm as possible and measure the circumference of your chest.</p> <p>Please note the measurements on the tape.</p> <p>Please look at the diagram for reference.</p> |  |
| <p><i>Measuring width or circumference of waist</i></p> | |  |
| <p><i>Measuring length of shirt/kaftan</i></p> | <p>Place the measuring tape at the highest point of your shoulder. This can be found where the shoulder meets the neck. Hold the tape there, and trace the measuring tape down until you reach the middle of your thumb.</p> <p>Make note of the distance on the measuring tape.</p> <p>Please refer to the picture and video for reference.</p> | |

HOW TO MEASURE TROUSERS

| <p><i>Measurement of Waist</i></p> | <p>Take your measuring tape and start with the waist. Run your tape around the waist, like a circle, and make this measurement as firm as possible.</p> |  Three views of a man measuring his waist with a yellow tape. | <p><i>Measurement of Hips</i></p> | <p>Take your measuring tape and go around the widest area of the hips, which means the tape will go around the back over the bottom. Make sure there is nothing in the pant pockets (front and back pockets). Make sure that there's nothing in the pockets and that it is as firm and as comfortable as possible.</p> |  Three views of a man measuring his hips with a yellow tape. | <p><i>Measuring width or circumference of trouser leg</i></p> | <p>Take your measuring tape and go around your thigh, like a circle. Make sure it is as comfortable as possible for ease of movement. Make sure there is nothing in the pant pockets (front and back pockets).</p> |  Three views of a man measuring his thigh with a yellow tape. The first view is a front view, the second is a side profile view, and the third is a back view. The man is wearing dark shorts and the tape is positioned around the widest part of his thigh. |

| <p><i>Measure width or circumference of knee</i></p> | <p>Take your measuring tape and go around the knee, like a circle. Please make it as comfortable as possible to accommodate for movement.</p> |  |
| <p><i>Measure width or circumference of calf</i></p> | <p>Take your measuring tape and go around the calf, like a circle. Please make it as comfortable as possible to accommodate for movement.</p> |  |
| <p><i>Measuring length of trousers</i></p> | <p>Take your measuring tape and start at the point where the trouser sits on your waist. From that point, trace the measuring tape down to the foot and stop about two inches after the ankle bone. That is the measurements for the length of your trousers.</p> |  |

Measuring width or circumference of ankle

Take off shoes. Using the measuring tape, make a circle around the ankle.

Please note that this area will be the end of your trousers. So, takes into consideration the wearing and removing of the trousers for best comfort and fit.
